[Tiki19](#) now has a great solution. Converts wiki pages to Slideshow format with a nice [mPDF](#) export: [Tiki19](#)

[BigBlueButton](#) permits great [webinars](#) thanks to the [presentation feature](#), which supports uploading PDF, Excel, PowerPoint, Word or an image.

How can we have a Tiki page as a presentation?

Todo: Make Tiki [Slideshow](#) exportable as a PDF via [wkhtmltopdf](#) or [PhantomJS](#).

- option A: one per page per slide (default)
- option B: one per page per bullet

[page breaks](#) should work with [wkhtmltopdf](#)
