There should be a table that holds a version number of the current database schema. On upgrade this version number is increased by one. Just put the statement:

```
update tiki_version set schema_version=23;
```

at the end of the upgrade script. subversions could handle developer issues.

You could also add version numbers for each table and change the upgrade script to verify the table after upgrade - but that needs much manual work.
