Plugin invocations with no arguments (e.g. SUP) when edited with the wikiplugin_editor, and without the hack in place get name value pairs such as:

\$family

each

clean

associate

link

contains

extend

<i>clean</i>	function () clean
<i>associate</i>	function (C) associate

<i>getLast</i>	function () getLast
<i>getRandom</i>	function () getRandom
