Description

Tiki automatically includes the "id" attribute for headings. For example:



```
!my heading
```

Becomes:

```
{CODE()}
```

```
<h1 id="my_heading">my heading</h1>
```

By default, the value of id is the text of the heading. However, as per the XHTML specification, id *must* begin with a letter — not a digit.

Therefore, if I have:



```
!2009 Highlights
```

Tiki generates:



```
<h1 id="2009_Highlights">my heading</h1>
```

Which is invalid.

Solution

When parsing headings, Tiki needs to ensure that the generated id element always starts with a letter.
